### I. System Requirements

- Windows Operating System: Windows 10 is recommended.
  (.Net Framework may be installed automatically as per the requirement of Edulib.in Player)
- 2. Good Internet Connectivity
- 3. Works in **Windows 7 and later versions**, provided .Net framework and other dependencies are installed properly. Refer Point No. III, if the player is opening after successful implementation.

## II. Instructions to install Edulib.in Player to Play the Content.

### Visit www.edulib.in

Download the "Edulib.in Player". Check the "Downloads" folder or wherever you have downloaded the "Edulib.in Player(beta).zip" file.

COEMPT

This may ask permission to install **Edulib.in Player** in your Computer/Laptop, and allow permission. Follow the instructions and complete the installation.



After successful installation, a shortcut to **Edulib.in Player** will be created on your desktop.



Also, you can run "Edulib.in Player" from Programs -> Edulib.in Player

Open the Edulib.in Player by double-click, it will open "Edulib.in" with Login Page.



If you are already a registered user in Edulib.in, you can login with your Login Details. Otherwise, you can create a new account and login.



# III. Additional files to be installed, even after successful installation of Edulib.in, but not working.

In some versions of Windows 7 or above, the Edulib.in Player may not open even after successful installation.

In such cases, follow the steps given below.

### Step-1:

Uninstall Edulib.in Player already installed, if any.

### Step-2:

Double-click and install "NDP452-KB2901907-x86-x64-AllOS-ENU.exe"

### Step-3:

Double-click and install "vcredist\_x86.exe"

#### Step-4:

Double-click or Run "EduLib.in Player(beta).msi" and follow the onscreen instructions as shown in Point No. II.
